4 Name Tags, School Uniform and Religious Items

We would like to remind Parents that the students' name tags form part of the school attire. All name tags are to be sewn 1 cm above the shirt pocket of the school shirt and 1 cm above the School Crest for the school polo-shirt. Students are given till end of February to get their name tags sewn on their school attire.

Back covered shoes and white socks are part of the school uniform. We would like to clarify that school approved footwear have the following features:

- Covered black shoes for boys and girls. No Mary Janes for girls. Black shoes with white or other colored soles are not approved school shoe designs.
