3. Values Inculcation – Responsibility

4. TraceTogether (TT) Token/App in Schools

ST1 and ST3

The usage of TT Token/App in schools is currently <u>not compulsory.</u> However, students are <u>encouraged</u> to be part of the nationwide contact tracing effort by having a TT Token or App with them in schools.

To prevent the loss of TT Tokens, students are encouraged to personalize their tokens by using a permanent ink marker to write their name/class on their token to facilitate the returning of the tokens to the rightful owners.

<u>Students who have lost their tokens</u> should try to find their misplaced TT tokens from the school's lost and found. This is where the personalisation of tokens would help to facilitate the recovery process.
