2.	<p><u>Updates to COVID-19 Precautionary Measures</u></p> <p>In line with the recent tightening measures announced by MTF, schools will implement temporary measures from <u>8 May to 30 May</u> to mitigate the potential risk of transmission from the community and within schools. These measures are based on the following considerations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Minimising disruption to core curricular programmes and students' learning; 2. Cohortising students by classes and CCAs; 3. Reducing overall activity sizes to a maximum of 50 individuals and group work size to five; and 4. Minimising the intermingling of students and staff across schools and with public. 	ST1 and ST3

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3.	<p data-bbox="180 271 850 302"><u>Travel Advisory for students for June Holidays.</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="180 338 1410 544">1. Students are reminded that they should continue to defer all travel overseas unless it is permissible under the prevailing MOH's travel advisory. (e.g. general travel to Australia, Brunei Darussalam, New Zealand, Mainland China and Taiwan, air travel bubble between Singapore and Hong Kong w.e.f 26 May 2021). Returning travellers from most countries/regions would be placed on Stay Home Notice (SHN), and schools would be alerted to such cases through MOE.<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="180 584 1410 831">a) <u>Travel Bubble between Singapore-Hong Kong.</u> Individuals who choose to travel to Hong Kong should also be reminded that the Air Travel Bubble Flights between Singapore and Hong Kong would be monitored by the authorities. If the seven-day moving average of the daily number of unlinked local COVID-19 cases is more than five in either Singapore or Hong Kong, the travel bubble would be suspended for at least 14 days. The suspension will take effect after two days (including the day on which the criteria were met) for a two-week period.<li data-bbox="180 837 1410 976">b) The same travel advice in the preceding paragraphs applies to SC (Singapore Citizens)/PR (Permanent Resident) students. While International Students (IS) are not stopped from making June-holiday travel plans, it is important that they understand the risks related to travelling out of Singapore.<li data-bbox="180 1010 1410 1077">2. Individuals who choose to travel against school's advice should be reminded that the following would apply:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="233 1111 1410 1249">a) The actual time spent overseas would be limited since travellers need to adhere to travel requirements to the country of travel as well as Singapore's requirements for entry. Students should factor in time to serve SHN before the date they are required to report back to school in Term 3;<li data-bbox="233 1256 1410 1491">b) Requirement to apply for entry approval for<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="312 1283 1410 1422">i. International Students (Student Pass) (IS-STP): To obtain approval via the Safe Travel Office (STO) through the online portal (https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/STO) at least two weeks before their intended travel date, and up to about two months in advance.<li data-bbox="312 1429 1410 1491">ii. International Students (Dependant Pass) (IS-DP): To obtain approval from MOM through employer of parents/guardian<li data-bbox="233 1498 1410 1626">c) Stay-Home Notice (SHN) of up to 21 days issued upon their return to Singapore may be chargeable up to \$3,000 if served at an SHN Dedicated Facility (refer to ICA website at https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/sc-pr/requirements-and-process for updated list of countries, where individuals would have to serve SHN at dedicated facilities);<li data-bbox="233 1632 1410 1700">d) COVID-19 PCR test before and/or upon arrival, during and at the end of the SHN may be chargeable up to \$200 per test;<li data-bbox="233 1706 1410 1774">e) mandatory travel insurance and unsubsidised healthcare if they come down with COVID-19 upon their return, if applicable. <div data-bbox="180 1805 1385 1944" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"><p data-bbox="180 1816 1145 1848">f) Students who are travelling overseas are reminded to closely monitor</p><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="233 1854 1366 1921">• local news, MOH website and ICA website for the most updated border measures</div>	ST1

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	<p><u>Travel Declarations</u> Only those who intend to travel will need to submit their travel declarations. Those not travelling need not submit a travel declaration. Students who intend to travel are required to submit their travel declarations between 12 May (Wednesday) and 21 May 2021 (Friday) via PG. If there is any change of plans after submission of the travel declaration, parents are requested to call the General Office and provide the updates <u>before 21 May 2021</u>. Students are also reminded to check the entry requirements imposed by the country/region of travel, and to take the necessary precautionary measures, observe good personal hygiene, monitor local developments, and heed the advice of local authorities.</p> <p><u>INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (IS)</u> ISes who are travelling out of Singapore are reminded to apply for entry approval to return to Singapore via the Safe Travel Office (STO) online portal (https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/STO). This may be done up to about two months in advance. They may refer to the step-by-step guide on the STO website (https://go.gov.sg/stplane), to self-help through the application process. They may also call the Safe Travel Enquiries Helpline at 6812 5555, or write in to https://go.gov.sg/sto-enquiry, if assistance is required.</p>	ST
4	<p><u>Parents picking up students by car</u> There have been observations where drivers were seen in their cars parked at the car porch, waiting to pick up their children after afternoon activities. This has caused obstruction to other drivers whose children are already waiting for them at the pick-up point.</p> <p>Going forward, we will not allow waiting at the car porch. Drivers will be required to pick up their passengers and leave immediately. If the intended passengers are not at the pick-up point, drivers will need to remove their vehicles and park at the sheltered bus bay. If there is no more parking space at the sheltered bus bay, they will need to drive out of school and come in later or wait at the multi-storey car park next to the school.</p> <p>Thanking you in advance for your understanding and cooperation in this matter.</p> <div data-bbox="432 1339 1145 1816" data-label="Image"></div> <p>Only park/wait at the sheltered bus bay (within the yellow boxes), or any available parking lots beside the car porch (except the lot for the disabled).</p>	ST1 and ST3
