COVID-19 Safe Management Updates With the sharp increase in the number of community cases, including the spike in unlinked cases, there is a need to reduce interactions and avoid the risk of large clusters. As such, MOE has stepped up precautionary measures to safeguard the well-being of all students and staff. All primary, secondary, junior college (JC) and Millennia Institute (MI) students will shift to full Home-Based Learning (FHBL) from 19 May 2021 (Wednesday) till end of the term on 28 May 2021 (Friday). 	Where the school is concerned, please note that work will not be assigned on 26 May (Vesak Day) and 28 May (PCTC).				
	As Work-From-Home is once again the default work arrangement for workplaces, parents who are able to work from home are strongly encouraged to keep your children home during FHBL period.				
	Parents working in essential services or who are unable to secure alternative care arrangements are to contact the school by <u>4.00pm today</u> for assistance. School will review all requests on a case-by-case basis and will aim to revert to parents by end of the work day.				
	Parents with children enrolled in SCC are also strongly encouraged to keep your children home during FHBL period. Kindly note that SCC will only offer half-day care services on 19, 20, 21, 24, 25 & 27 May, and full-day care services on 28 May, the day scheduled for PCTC.				
	FHBL period and upcoming June Holidays During this period of FHBL and over the upcoming June Holidays, students are reminded to stay at home as much as possible and refrain from visiting each other's homes. Project meetings and other schoolwork that require collaboration should be done online. They should continue to practise good personal hygiene habits and adhere strictly to Safe Management Measures even whilst not in school.				
	For contact tracing purposes, students who return to school during FHBL and June holidays will be required to check in to SafeEntry using their TraceTogether Token and carry it with them at all times. Students who are unwell, or who have household members on Home Quarantine Order/Stay Home Notice or have unwell adult household members with flu-like symptoms such as fever and cough, are required to stay away from school.				
	We strongly urge parents and students to play their part by continuing to be socially responsible and remain vigilant to ensure the continued safety and well-being of everyone.				
	Implementation of FHBL During the FHBL phase, students will access a range of both online and hardcopy HBL materials, so that learning continues uninterrupted. The Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) platform will also be used.
