3. Transition to Pen for P3 Students



As communicated at the Start-of-Year Meet-the-FTs session in Term 1, P3 students will be making the transition to the use of pen starting from Term 3 2021. The students will be guided by their teachers to transit to <u>Blue / Black ink pen</u> for daily work / assignments, and <u>Green ink pen</u> for corrections. To cultivate good writing habits, *students should not use pens with erasable ink, and correction tape is discouraged (though students may use it sparingly in transitional years*). Your child would <u>continue to require 2B pencils as well</u> (for example, for shading of OAS). As subject requirements and/or children's readiness may differ, we seek your understanding to take cue from your child's teachers on when to use ink. In the meantime, we seek your help to get the necessary stationery ready for your child's use. Thank you.

4. Dismissal of P4 Students at Gate 4 from Term 3, Week 2, 6 July 2021

To help decongest the area outside Gate 2 during this Heightened Alert phase, the P4 students will be dismissed at Gate 4 (see diagram below) with effect from Term 3, Week 2 (week beginning 5 Jul 2021).



We seek parents and caregivers' understanding and support in partnering the school to ensure safe distancing while waiting at the various dismissal points. Our P4 students will be able to make their way home on their own, or meet up with you at a further meeting point at any of the nearby blocks during dismissal.

5.	ECCA (CCA virtual format) for Selected CCA Groups	ST1			
	With the need to minimise intermingling among students, physical CCA will continue to be suspended until Term 3 Week 5 (week beginning 26 Jul 2021). Selected CCA groups will be conducting their CCA practices online. The coverage will be based on the nature of the CCA and student needs. Hence, not all P3 and P4 students will be involved in ECCA. Teachers in-charge of the respective selected CCAs will be providing further details through Parents Gateway. Please note that students will be attending their ECCA sessions at home with the exception for students who attend SCC(Student Care Center) in school. Arrangements will be made for these students to attend their ECCA sessions in school.				
6.	ALP- Focused Skills Training for Primary 4 The school will be conducting a two-session Focused Skills Training workshop (via Zoom video conferencing with external trainers) for our Primary 4 students. The students will be guided by their teachers, to make and create artefacts incorporating creativity, as well as the application of Mathematical and Science concepts. The students will get to work with materials and tools to complete their projects and strengthen their fine motor development. Through this experience, we hope that our students will learn to be responsible and resilient, and develop good problem-solving skills while completing their projects. The workshop will adhere to Safe Management Measures guidelines. We are pleased to inform that this workshop is fully sponsored by the school.
