5.	<p><u>Mid-Autumn Appreciation Programme</u> In foster an inclusive community, the school constantly exposes students to the culture of different ethnic groups. Towards this end, the Mother Tongue Language (MTL) department will be organizing programmes to help students appreciate the Mid-Autumn Festival. The event will take place on Tuesday, 21 Sep, during Mother Tongue periods. The programme line-up includes learning the origin of the festival, sharing of folk tales, cherished values and the customary practices associated with the festival.</p>	ST1								

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	<p>To help students internalize the value of care for the environment, P2 and P3 students will be making lanterns using recycled materials. Students will be briefed when the event date draws nearer.</p> <p>Primary 4 Lantern Making The MTL and Science Departments are collaborating to help students integrate their learning across different subjects. A different approach is adopted for the P4 level lantern making activity.</p> <p>During this September holidays, Primary 4 students will apply their learning in the topic of Light and Shadows in the making and design of lanterns, using recycled materials. Their lanterns will be showcased along the school corridors and classrooms.</p> <p>During the lantern making process, students will be challenged to design and make a lantern using different materials that allow different amounts of light to pass through. They will <u>submit their final product to their Science teachers on Monday, 13 Sep 2021</u>. All students will receive the task sheet and the light source from their Science teachers this week. To further support our students, an SLS package- "Light up Challenge"- will be uploaded with videos to assist students in their lantern making effort.</p> <p>We hope that our students will enjoy the lantern making experience.</p>	ST
