Background

Plans for Teachers' Day Celebration 2021

TDC 2021 will be a combination of efforts from the different divisions in MOE HQ and the celebrations will take place across 4 fronts:

- (iv) National Online: Gratitude Portal and Social Media (i.e. engagement of parents and public)

The online Gratitude Portal will be a symbolic gift to appreciate and affirm all staff in education, hosted at <u>ThankYouCher.edu.sg.</u> The title 'Thank You 'Cher' is relatable to educators in Singapore, and captures the main theme of the site through the voice of those who matters most to them - the students under their charge. The portal will allow for submissions of appreciation from students, parents, former students and fellow educators. Posts are tagged by school, and submissions can be filtered to show posts thanking teachers, and staff of individual schools. Messages can also be accompanied by a photo or image.

	The MTL department is organizing an enrichment programme for P3 and P4 CL students and P3 ML students. 	Mother Tongue Language Fortnight To create a conducive environment that promote the use and learning of MTL beyond the classroom and school, the school designates the period between 20 Aug to 2 Sep as the MTL Fortnight. During this period, a wide range of activities related to CL/ML/TL language and culture will be conducted. Activities include workshops, language games, talks, quizzes, competitions, talent showcases, cultural craftwork and performing arts events. Students are expected to complete some of the cultural craftwork at home. Parents are encouraged to complete these activities with your child as part of family bonding.

LTA Handbrake Requirement for Bicycles Over the past few years, we have seen an increase in the number of people using bicycles as a mode of transport or for leisure, especially since the COVID-19 pandemic. This may include students who cycle to and from school, or during the weekends with friends and families. Some of these students who cycle may be fixie enthusiasts. Fixies, also known as fixed-gear bicycles, generally do not have hand-operated brakes, but instead rely on the rider's pedal resistance to stop. This makes it challenging for riders to brake quickly, endangering themselves and other path and road users.	ST1 ST3			
	To improve safety, <u>from 1 September 2021</u> , all bicycles ridden on public paths and roads must have <u>at least one</u> functioning handbrake. Cyclists caught riding without handbrakes may be fined up to \$10 000 or jailed for up to 6 months if convicted for the first offence. Repeat offenders may face higher penalties.
