- Students' learning progress will be based on existing School-Based Assessments (SBA) data and students' learning evidence:
 - School will report the available weighted assessment results, subject overall score, and overall score in the Holistic Development Profile (HDP), supplemented with qualitative comments on students' overall learning.
- The school will print the Mid-Year Assessments (MYA) results, subject overall score, and overall score without the EYA results.
