Therefore, students will be allowed to return to school while on CCT/HRW as long as they are covered by a valid Ag With the change, the swab can be done the night before which will provide parents the necessary flexibility.	and ST3		
	2. TraceTogether(TT) Tokens. From Saturday, 20 Nov onwards and in 2022, contact tracing for Primary, Secondary and JCCIs will be fully TT-based and no manual contact tracing will be conducted. Students are reminded to ensure that their TT Tokens are in working order and to get a replacement if their token is faulty or out of battery. Parents who completed the programmes reported improvements in four areas: 1. Greater parenting competence 2. Lower parenting stress 3. Improved emotional states and 4. Triple P Level 3 One-to-One Consultation

Triple P Level 3 is for parents who are facing some parenting issues and require one-on-one support. The consultation sessions offer practical strategies to help parents confidently manage their children's behaviour, prevent problems from developing and build strong, healthy relationships.

Duration:

4 sessions of 1 hour each

Triple P Level 4 Group Sessions

Triple P Level 4 is for parents with multiple concerns about their children's behaviour or those who are motivated to learn a variety of parenting skills to apply in various parenting situations. The group sessions help parents learn strategies that promote social competence and self-regulation in children as well as decrease problem behaviour.

Duration:

5 group sessions of 2h each as well as 3 individual telephone consultations of 20 min
