Should you choose not to register your child via EYC admissions for his or her guaranteed K1 place at the partner MK, or subsequently choose not to accept your child's guaranteed K1 place at the partner MK, your child's K1 place in the partner MK will be forfeited. If you wish to register your child at a non-partner MK, you should register using the OA registration form. Your application will be considered under the MK OA registration and subject to the same conditions as all other OA applications.

You can only register your child for one MK. If you need to amend your submitted registration details or wish to register your child for a different MK, you may re-submit a new application for your child. If you have submitted more than one OA applications or submitted your applications in both EYC and OA registration, MOE will only consider the latest application received within the stipulated MK registration period.
