5 Subscription of Chinese Language fortnightly reading materials

ST1

To inculcate an interest in reading Chinese reading materials, the Chinese Language Department is introducing the fortnightly reading materials NEW FRIENS or 新朋友(Primary 1 and 2), NEW WORLD or 新天地 (Primary 3 and 4), and NEW EXPRESS or 新列车(Primary 5 and 6) to students. These reading materials will be used as supplementary resources during Chinese Lessons and Uninterrupted Sustained Silent Reading designated on Thursday and Friday Mornings. The subscription includes the following:

- 20 issues of the reading materials which students will receive one copy fortnightly;
- an account to access the digital resources such as eChinese Animated Magazine, eAssignment & Question Bank, eOral Resources, Zhishi.Funland E-Magazine, eReading E-Book and eClassic story etc.

The school has made arrangements for students to subscribe to the reading materials using Edusave. An annual subscription fee of \$30 will be included in the next school bill. No action is required from parents in the meantime.

Upon subscription, the printed learning materials will be distributed by the respective Chinese Language teacher during Chinese lessons. A longer time is needed to set up the digital account. Hence, students will be notified regarding the online accessibility at a later date. Parents who have further enquiry may contact their child's Chinese Language teacher via email.
