Please also note the following assessment rules and regulations:

- 1. Students who are absent during the assessment must produce a <u>valid medical certificate</u> for the day. These students' marks will be pro-rated accordingly. **No marks will be given** for the paper if students are absent without a valid medical certificate.
- 2. Students who have registered a temperature at or above the trigger temperature, are ill/unwell or are covered by medical certificates on the day of the assessment will not be allowed to sit for it.
- 3. Latecomers will not be given additional time. Latecomers who miss the paper entirely will not be allowed to sit for the paper and no marks will be awarded to them.
- 4. There will be no make-up papers (except for Oral Assessments) for students who are absent on assessment days.
- 5. In line with PSLE guidelines, students are not allowed to bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices capable of storing and displaying visual or verbal information into the examination room as this will be construed as attempting to cheat.
- 6. Students who attempt to cheat during an assessment will not be awarded any marks for the paper.

4. Sending of Forgotten Items for Your Child

We have noticed an increasing trend of parents sending forgotten items such as stationery and attire to school to be handed over to the children. We would like to remind that this practice is strongly discouraged. The children need to learn to be responsible for their actions and face the consequences eg sitting out for a PE lesson because they are not properly attired. Following the timetable to know what to bring the next day and taking down instructions from their teachers are their responsibility and not their parents'. Henceforth, we will not be acceding to requests to deliver forgotten items to the students. Exceptions will be granted on a case-bycase basis. We seek Parents' understanding and cooperation on this matter to educate our children.

5. Young Scientist Badge Programme (P3 to P5 students)

To cultivate the sense of curiosity for the learning of Science concepts, P3 to P5 students will be participating in the Young Scientist Badge (YSB) programme starting from Term 2 Week 4 (Week beginning 11 Apr 2022). This programme is organised by Singapore Science Centre and the activities complement the students' learning of Science. Students will have up to Term 3 Week 2 (week beginning 4 Jul 2022) to accumulate at least 15 points minimally.

The programme encourages our students to carry out self-directed activities in various disciplines of science. Upon completion of the activities, they may submit their tasks online or directly to their respective Science teachers. With the accumulation of a minimum of 15 points, the students will be awarded with the Young Scientist badge and an e-certificate. Students who have already subscribed to this programme may link their personal account to the school's issued account. The respective Science teachers will be issuing the user ID and password to your child/ward starting from next week.
