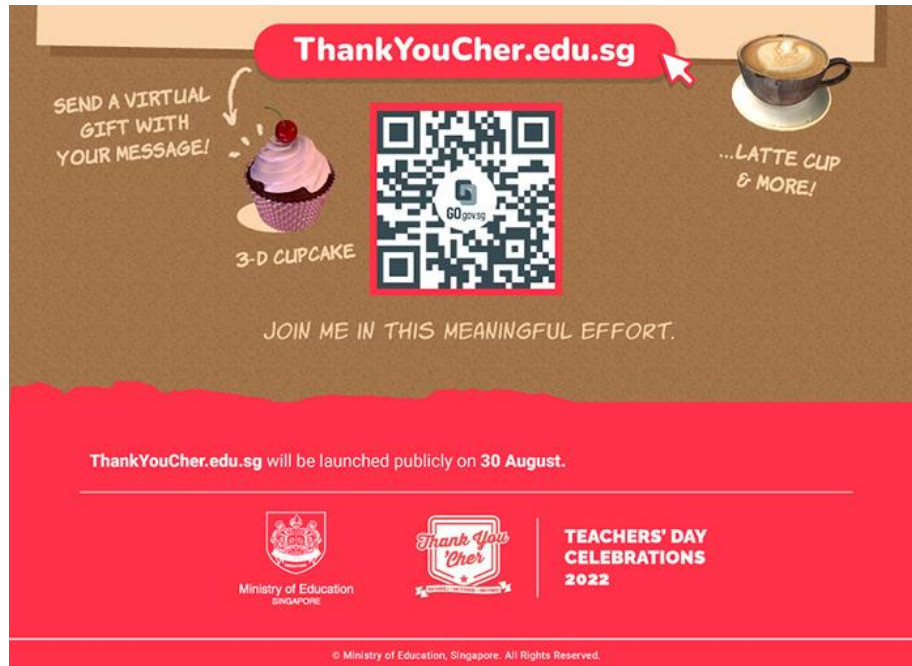

Primary 1

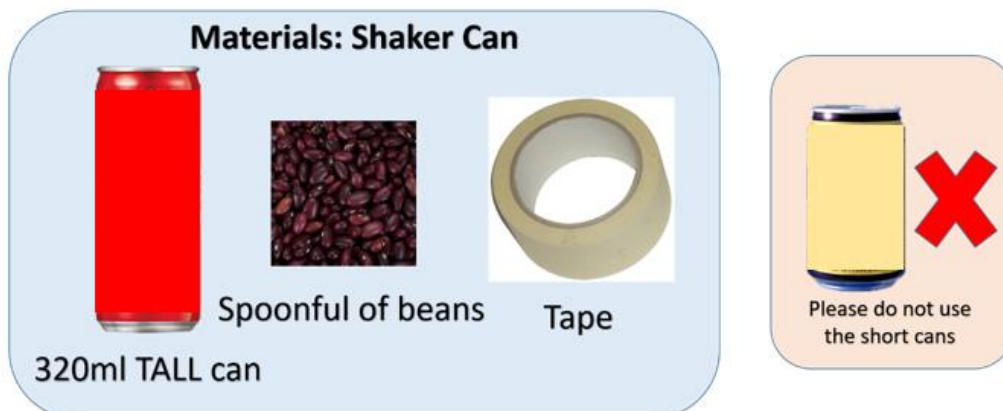
In preparation for the FGPS Artlympic Day on 6 October 2022, Primary 1 students will need to make **one** can shaker at home.

The video instructions on making the can shakers will be posted on the SLS platform. Students can view the video, '**P1 Making a Can Can Shaker**' for Artlympic Day 2022' from 31 August, 2.00pm.

They are required to bring the completed shaker to school and hand it in to their Form Teachers by **Monday, 12 September**.

Students are also encouraged to view the video, '**P1 Artlympic Day Games 2022**' on SLS to familiarise themselves with the format of the games that they will participating in on the day of the event.

**Primary 2**

In preparation for the FGPS Artlympic Day on 6 October 2022, Primary 2 students will need to make a paper baseball bat at home.

Primary 4

The video instructions on making the Javelin will be posted on the SLS platform. Students can view the video, '**P4 Making a Paper Javelin for Artlympic Day 2022**' from 31 August, 2.00pm.

Students are also required to view the video, '**P4 Artlympic Day Games 2022**' on SLS to familiarise themselves with the format of the games and the art activity, '**Street Art**'.

Primary 5
