	"Road Safety Challenge!" is an online interactive learning resource jointly developed by the Traffic Police and MOE for Primary 3 to Primary 6 students. This resource, uploaded in the Student Learning Space (SLS), aims to educate students on basic road safety rules and inculcate good safety habits through animated scenarios and interactive quizzes.				
	Students can learn road safety knowledge at their own time and pace. There are four levels in the interactive resource. After completing each level, a student will receive a <u>virtual</u> certificate of achievement. Those who completed <u>four levels</u> will be appointed as " Junior Road Safety Ambassadors ".				
	The interactive learning resource will be assigned to all P3 to P5 students via SLS on Monday, 29 August 2022. Please encourage your child to login to SLS anytime between 29 August and 3 October 2022 to complete the challenge.				
	To encourage schools and students to attempt the "Road Safety Challenge!", Traffic Police is giving out a special award to the top 10 schools that have the most number of students who complete the respective modules by 3 October 2022. Do encourage your child to revisit the interactive resource even though they may have completed all the levels by the deadline.
