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No. Item ST 6. P5: Use of Approved MTL Dictionary ST1

According to the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB), students are allowed to use approved dictionaries for Composition during PSLE. In addition, the Chinese Language students are allowed to use e-dictionaries. In alignment with this policy, the school will allow the use of dictionaries for the coming P5 End-Of-Year MTL Composition Assessment on 12 Octobrer 2022.
