3.	Enhancement to Ministry of Education Financial Assistance Scheme	ST1	
	The Ministry of Education (MOE) has enhanced the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS).	ST3	
	From 1 January 2023, Singapore Citizen students from households with gross monthly household income (GHI) of \$3,000 and below, or per capita income ^[1] (PCI) of \$750 and below, will be eligible for the MOE FAS.		
	MOE FAS recipients are not required to pay school fees and standard miscellaneous fees. Those in primary and secondary schools are also eligible for free textbooks, school attire, meals and transport subsidies ^[2] .		
	Parents can submit your application online via this website: <u>https://go.gov.sg/moe-efas</u> if you are eligible and wish to apply for the MOE FAS. Alternatively, you may submit the completed application form (download via the link below) to the school.

	 Application via hardcopy form is required for: a. families with other dependents (Great grandparents, Aunties/Uncles, Cousins and others) b. family with more than 5 children in GGAS (Government and Government-aided schools) c. family with more than 4 unmarried children not in GGAS d. family with more than 3 grandparents in the household 		
	Parent whose child is a ComCare recipient need not submit the application for MOE FAS as MOE FAS will be auto-granted to ComCare beneficiaries in GGAS.

Meal subsidy provision has also been raised. Transport and meals subsidies will start from the month after your application is approved.
