The OECD Learning Compass 2030 has identified three transformative competencies that students need to be future-ready, contribute to and thrive in an increasingly complex world. The transformative competencies are:

## a) Creating new value

This means innovating to shape better lives. Through cultivating the **habits of reflection and inquiry**, our students learn to challenge the status quo and try to think out of the box for new solutions.

#### b) Reconciling tensions and dilemmas

**Anchoring them in sound values** such as respect, care and resilience, students learn to empathize, consider opposing viewpoints and build sound arguments amidst uncertainty and complexity.

## c) <u>Taking responsibility</u>

Students learn to be **responsible leaders** who advocate for causes that will make a positive difference to Singapore and the world.

All children need caring adults to guide and support them. By partnering closely with parents and partners, and coordinating effort on many levels, we give all Fern Green students the roots (sound values, right attitudes and dispositions, stable, joyful and stimulating learning environments) and wings (future-ready transformative competencies) to fly. - choose pedagogical approaches appropriate to learners' readiness, interests and learning profiles; and
- develop their teaching competencies to enact classroom practices in alignment with the syllabuses and curriculum, as well as classroom-based innovations.
