2. P1&6 Students: Photo-Taking for the School Smart Card (SSC)

MOE will be conducting the yearly photo-taking exercise for all students in Primary One (P1) and Primary Six (P6) for the purpose of generating the School Smart Card (SSC). The photo-taking will be conducted by Transit Link's appointed vendor on behalf of MOE. The SSC serves as the student's identification card and can be used for concessionary travel on public transport and to borrow library books from the National Library Board and the school's library, amongst other usage.

The photo-taking session for our school is scheduled on <u>Friday</u>, 27 <u>January and Monday</u>, 30 <u>January</u>. Following the photo-taking, P1 students will get their SSCs by end March 2023, while the photos for P6 students will be used for the printing of Secondary SSCs when they are promoted to Secondary One in 2024. For P1 students, while pending the receipt of the SSCs, students can continue to use the Child Concession Card for free travel on public transport until 30 April 2023.

Please be informed that all P1 and P6 students are required to be dressed in their school attire for the photo-taking session. Please also ensure that your child's hair is neat and tidy.

If your child is unable to attend the photo-taking session, the school will either arrange for him/her to have his/her photo taken on another day or request for you to submit a softcopy photo to the school.

3. P3 CCA (Co-Curricular Activity) Experience

To better guide our P3 students in making informed decisions about their choices of CCAs, we will be providing them with opportunities to experience some of the CCAs that are being offered in school in Semester 1.

Each P3 student will be allowed to experience **two** CCAs from each of the following categories:

- Physical Sports,
- Visual and Performing Arts,
- Clubs and Societies, and Uniform Groups.

All P3 class have been scheduled for the CCA experience (please see schedule below). Students and parents are to take note of the dates assigned and the corresponding CCA categories and CCAs.

On the assigned days, students will be allowed to partake in two CCAs from the assigned categories for **45 minutes** each:

- First CCA of Choice:
 - 2.40pm to 3.25pm
- Second CCA of Choice:
 - 3.35pm to 4.20pm



Revised Income Eligibility Criteria for Priority Order 1 Registrants

From the 2023 MK Registration Exercise, the income cap to be eligible for Priority Order 1 registrants will be raised in view of rising income levels. To ensure that MKs remain accessible to children from lower-income households, one-third of MK K1 places will be reserved for Singapore Citizens (SCs) from households who live within 1km of the kindergarten with Gross Household Income (GHI) not exceeding \$4,500 per month, or Per Capita Income (PCI) not exceeding \$1,125 per month. SCs from these eligible households would be admitted to MKs under Priority Order 1.

Details of 2023 MK Registration Exercise

The 2023 MK Registration Exercise is open to SC and Permanent Resident (PR) children born between 2 January 2019 and 1 January 2020, both dates inclusive. Parents can register their child for admission to an MK via the MK website (www.moe.gov.sg/mk), from 9am on 17 February 2023 to 4pm on 21 February 2023. Parents will be informed of the registration outcome by 14 April 2023. Outside this registration period, parents can seek admission to K1 or K2 for their child by contacting the MK directly to check if there are vacancies.

2023 MK Open House

The 55 MKs participating in the 2023 MK Registration Exercise will hold their open houses on either 11 or 18 February 2023. Parents are encouraged to visit and learn more about each individual MK's curriculum, programmes, interactive learning environment and facilities as well as speak to the MK Educators. The open houses will allow parents to better understand the MKs before registering their child in their preferred MKs.

8. **Grandparenting Seminar**

Methodist Welfare Services Family Support Programme (MWS FSP), in conjunction with Triple P (Positive Parenting Program), is organising Grandparenting seminars which will be conducted <u>in</u> Mandarin.
