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P1&2 Safe Cycling Programme 2023 (Part of ALP: Get REAL!@FGPS)

The Safe Cycling Programme have commenced this week and will run till the end of the term. Students are to be dressed in their PE Attire and bring a bottle of water for the programme.

P1 Pots & Hands Music Milestone Programme

The Pots & Hands Music Milestone Programme would allow the students to immerse in music-making using everyday objects in an ensemble setting with their classmates. At the end of the enrichment programme, students would be familiar with various instrumental polyrhythms, timbres and tones synthesising together. This would help hone their musical awareness, sensitivity and appreciation.

P2 Handbell Music Milestone Programme

The Handbell Music Milestone Programme provides opportunity for students to learn and play as a team using handbells. While students learn the basic skills of playing the handbells, they also practise using eye-hand coordination as well as distinguishing sounds of different pitch. Students would learn the correct posture of holding and playing the handbells. They will also be taught how to read the music score using solfege and play a song using the handbells as a class at the end of the second session.

P1 Rope Skipping Exposure

The school has engaged Singapore Jump Rope Academy to conduct two sessions of basic rope skipping for all P1 students during school hours. The programme aims to develop fundamental skills of co-ordination in our students and help them build fitness, strength and agility. At the end of the programme, we hope that students will continue to engage in this fitness activity at their own time.

P1&P2 ICT Baseline Training

The school has planned for a 3-session training module to ensure all students possess the necessary ICT competencies in alignment with the MOE ICT Baseline Standards. These standards outline the minimum level of proficiency required in areas such as digital literacy, safe and responsible technology use, etc. The objective is to provide students with the skills they need to effectively leverage technology for learning and to safely navigate the digital world.

P2 Applied Learning Programme (ALP): Maker Education

Students will be exposed to projects that encourage them to use everyday materials and STEM concepts in order to design and build solutions to problems. Through the ALP, students are encouraged to connect the academic curriculum to the real world and to become more motivated and purposeful about acquiring new skills and knowledge.
