At the P1&2 levels, non-weighted Class-Level Assessments (CLAs) will be conducted in Term 2, during lesson time, to inform students, teachers and parents of students' learning progress.

Separately, P1&2 Subject Teachers will be reporting on students' attainment levels of the subject-specific Learning Outcomes.
