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2. Primary School Transfer Service Cycle 2/2023

The aim of the Primary School Transfer Service is to centrally facilitate the transfer of P1-P5 primary school students who are Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (SPR) and have relocated to another address to schools nearer to their new residences.

The application periods have been planned to facilitate students' reporting to the new primary school offered at the start of the school term. Cycle 2 will commence from 9.00am on Monday, 15 May and end on Thursday, 1 June 2023 at 4.00pm. Parents are to submit your child's school transfer application online to MOE via www.moe.gov.sg/primary/transfers

Parents will be informed of the outcome of the application via SMS on 19 June 2023 and are to report to your child's current and receiving schools to finalise the transfer from 20 to 23 June 2023.

3. e-Learning Day for All P3 to P6 Students Taking Higher Mother Tongue Languages (HMTL)

As part of our efforts to integrate blended learning for **students taking Higher Mother Tongue Languages**, **e-Learning** will be conducted on

- 18 & 25 May 2023 for all P3 to P6 HMTL students;
- 19 & 26 May 2023 for all P6 HML students.

Please note that the students will not be required to stay back after school on the abovementioned dates for their HMTL lessons.

Students are required to complete the online assignments (assigned by their Subject Teachers via SLS) before they return for face-to-face discussions in their respective classes when school reopens in Term 3. Respective Subject Teachers will be providing the necessary instructions to the students closer to the dates.

4. P1&2: Speech and Drama Performances, "Little Stars of Broadway"

The Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Department has organised a Speech and Drama enrichment programme for all P2 students in Term 2. This programme aims to build our students' confidence in using their Mother Tongue Languages and develop their interest in learning the languages.

To offer our young learners a platform to apply and showcase what they have just learnt, the team is organising a Speech and Drama performance titled, "Little Stars of Broadway" where the students

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will be encouraged to put up short presentations/performances in the form of role-plays, poem recitals, songs, etc. before our parents audience.

Fun Science @Recess will be a monthly event held during the three recesses (at the sheltered basketball court) with the help of our parent volunteers and Science Leaders.

Students are welcome to join us at our first Fun Science @Recess event on Thursday, 18 May, where fun science activities await them. There will be opportunities for all to discover new knowledge and draw connections between science and their everyday lives!

6. P3: Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) Selection for 2023

We would like to extend our appreciation to all P3 parents for supporting and giving consent for your child to participate in the CCA experience that was conducted between February and April. We hope the experience has allowed for your child to make an informed decision about their choice(s) of CCA.

Kindly note that the official CCA selection/recruitment exercise for P3 students will commence on **10 May 2023.** After this CCA selection/recruitment exercise, the students will be allocated a CCA and will begin their CCA journey in Term 3.

CCAs are an integral part of our students' holistic education. While CCA is **not compulsory** in primary schools, participation in CCA fosters social integration and deepens students' sense of belonging, commitment and sense of responsibility to school, community and nation.

The purpose and intent of CCAs are:

- To provide students with a platform to discover interest and talents.
- To help students acquire useful life skills and 21st Century Competencies to be:
 - ✓ A Confident Person
 - ✓ A Self-Directed Learner
 - ✓ A Concerned Citizen
 - ✓ An Active Contributor
- To cater to a broad spectrum of interests and talents.
