3.	<u>Primary School Transfer Service: Cycle 3 (2023)</u>
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The aim of the Primary School Transfer Service is to centrally facilitate the transfer of primary school students who are Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (SPR) and have relocated to another address, to schools nearer to their new residences.

The application periods have been planned to facilitate students' reporting to the new primary school offered at the start of the school term. Cycle 3 will **commence from 9.00am on 1 November and end at 4.00pm on 23 November 2023**. Parents are to submit your child's school transfer application online to MOE via www.moe.gov.sg/primary/transfers

Parents will be informed of the **outcome of the application** via SMS on **7 December 2023** and parents are to report to your child's **current and receiving schools** to finalise the transfer from 8 to 29 December 2023.

4.	<u>2024 Chinese Development Assistance Council (CDAC) Tuition Programme</u>
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The Chinese Development Assistance Council (CDAC) invites students to apply for the 2024 CDAC Tuition Programme via myCDAC online portal **from 1 November 2023**.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Student or one of the parents must be a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident.
2. Student must be attending a Government/Government-Aided School in Singapore.
3. Gross Monthly Household Income \$4,800 and below or Per Capita Income \$1,400 and below.

5.	<p><u>Sengkang Methodist Church (SKMC) Bursary Programme</u></p> <p>As part of its outreach into the community, SKMC gives out bursary awards to Primary and Secondary students each year. It aims to provide financial assistance to all deserving applicants.</p> <p>The eligibility criteria for the SKMC Bursary for 2024, which is open for application from 23 October 2023 to 17 November 2023 at 2.00pm, are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Applicant must be a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident;2) Applicant must be studying in either a government or government-aided Primary School or Secondary School for academic year 2024;3) Applicant's family Per Capital Income (PCI) must not exceed \$800 per person or Gross Household Income not exceeding \$3,200 (GHI); and4) Applicant must not be receiving any other scholarship or bursary for the academic year 2024. <p>Parents may get a copy of the application form from SKMC's security counter at Level 1 at 31 Anchorvale Road, Singapore 545056 during office hours (Mondays to Fridays, 9am to 5pm) or by visiting https://bit.ly/SKMCBURSARY2024.</p> <p>For enquiries, please call SKMC at 6395 9455 or email SKMC at office@skmc.org.sg.</p>
6.	<p><u>Ready for School Kit (by Central Singapore Community Development Council)</u></p> <p>The Ready for School Kit supports low-income families, with school-going children, who face additional financial burden during the back-to-school season. 
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WECARE @ NORTH EAST FUND
