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2. Chinese New Year (CNY) Celebrations on Friday, 9 February

This year, the Chinese New Year (CNY) holidays fall on 10 and 11 February.

Please note that

- there will be **no school** on <u>Monday</u>, <u>12 February</u> and <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>13 February</u> as 12 February is a public holiday and 13 February is a school holiday;
- school will resume on Wednesday, 14 February.

The school will be having our CNY celebrations and concert on **Friday**, **9 February** (eve of CNY), and students will be **dismissed earlier** at around 10.30am on that day. Students are to report to school by 7.30am and would be dismissed by the level, according to the following timings:

- P1 and P2 at 10.25am
- P3 and P4 at 10.30am
- P5 and P6 at 10.35am

Students are reminded to bring along their snack for their snack break **at 8.15am** as the <u>canteen will</u> not be operating on that day.

In our bid to foster a better understanding and an appreciation of the diverse cultures within the school community, students will be engaged in craftwork centred around the Chinese culture on that day. As such, lessons will be suspended and students will only be required to bring along their snack and a storybook to school. The CNY concert will commence right after the class activities at 8.45am.

Please also note the following **rules and regulations** for all weighted assessments:

- Students who are absent during the assessment must produce a <u>valid medical certificate</u> for the day. These students' marks will be pro-rated accordingly. No marks will be given for the paper if students are absent without a valid medical certificate.
- 2. Students who have registered a temperature at or above the trigger temperature, are ill/unwell or are covered by medical certificates on the day of the assessment will not be allowed to sit for it
- 3. Latecomers will not be given additional time. Latecomers who miss the paper entirely **will not be allowed** to sit for the paper and **no marks will be awarded to them**.
- 4. There will be no make-up papers (except for Oral Assessments) for students who are absent on assessment days.
- 5. In line with PSLE guidelines, students are not allowed to bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices capable of storing and displaying visual or verbal information into the examination room as this will be construed as attempting to cheat.
- 6. Students who attempt to cheat during an assessment **will not be awarded any marks** for the paper.
