# 2. Total Defence Day 2024: Together We Keep Singapore Strong

Total Defence Day 2024 will mark 40 Years of Total Defence (TD40). Singapore will be commemorating Total Defence Day (TDD) on Thursday, 15 February 2024. The focus for TD40 will be on Singaporean's readiness and resilience in the face of crises and disruptions. Total Defence underpins our ability to deal with the ever-evolving threats and challenges to Singapore. Every Singaporean plays a part in our daily lives to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruption.

As part of our continued commitment to National Education, the school will be conducting an engagement session on 1 February 2024 to engage students in understanding the significance of TDD. To further instil the core message that every Singaporean has a part to play to help strengthen our defences against threats and challenges, a TDD performance will be showcased during assembly on Monday, 5 February 2024. TDD recess activities will also be conducted on 14 February 2024. Students will also learn more about TDD through their FTGP lessons.

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Events in recent years have made it more apparent how Singapore can be susceptible to various disruptions of resources key to our basic needs. As such disruptions become more likely, we need to prepare our students to be agile and responsive to disruptions. For students to experience the possible effects of such disruptions and consider how they can respond calmly and responsibly, the school will be conducting a TD40 Energy Disruption Exercise in T1W7.

# 3. Safer Internet Day 2024

Safer Internet Day (SID) is an annual global initiative aimed at promoting safer and more responsible use of online technology and mobile devices among children and young people. Safer Internet Day 2024 lands on 6 February and the theme for schools and students is "Digital Wellbeing and having a Healthy and Balanced relationship with Technology". While technology will always be a part of our lives, using technology excessively can also be problematic. Balancing our technology use and taking the time to unplug from technology use can be a useful way of ensuring equilibrium.

Below is an activity which parents can work hand-in-hand with our teachers to help promote and reinforce the above key messages with our children.

# **Activity**

# Step 1: Commit to a screen-free weekend on 3 & 4 February 2024!

Students can commit to **one** of the following screen-free options for the weekend of 3 & 4 February:

- Not using mobile devices
- Not engaging in recreational screen time
- Not playing video games

# Step 2: Replace screentime with another activity!

All of us have the same 24 hours in a day. Not being online allow us extra time to spend offline. Replace the time normally spend online with something to do offline. Below are some suggested activities:

- Playing a sport
- Outdoor activities such as hiking/cycling etc.
- Spending time with friends in a face-to-face setting
- Family members to engage in a screen-free weekend and take part in a family activity (e.g. board games)

# Step 3: Parents are invited to join along!

Parents to join in for a screen-free weekend and engage in some offline activities together. Have an enjoyable screen-free weekend!

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# Step 4: Students are to take the Cyber Wellness Pledge on page 29 of the Student Handbook!

Students are to go through the Cyber Wellness Pledge on page 29 of the Student Handbook and pledge to build positive online habits guided by our R<sup>3</sup>ICH school values by signing at the bottom of the page. Parents are also encouraged to show your support by signing on the same page, to help all foster a healthy digital environment.

# 4. CCA Experience for P3 Students

In our continued effort to provide a holistic education, CCAs will be offered to all students from P3 onwards. To help our P3 students make an informed choice while selecting a CCA in Term 2, 2024, the school will be scheduling CCA experience sessions from 27 February to 16 April 2024 to allow them to experience some of the CCAs offered in Fern Green.

Objectives of the CCA experience sessions:

- Provide our P3 students with some exposure to the CCAs offered in school;
- Serve as platforms for them to discover their diverse interests;
- Help them to make an informed choice about their CCAs which will commence in Semester 2, 2024

The CCA experience sessions will be conducted on Tuesdays (from 2.30pm to 4.30pm), while the CCAs are being carried out.

More details of the experience sessions will be shared with parents and students nearer to the commencement date.

# 5. P4 'Camp Unity' 2024

The school will be organising a 3D2N residential Outdoor Adventure Learning Camp, a milestone programme, for all P4 students at the end of this term. The theme for this year's cohort camp is 'Unity'.

- cooperate with one another to achieve common goals and overcome challenges as a team;
- harness leadership qualities and team building skills through group activities to build camaraderie whilst experiencing inter-dependence living with other students.
