Presented by the Speak Good English Movement and The Straits Times with the support of the Ministry of Education, the Inspiring Teacher of English Award is a national award that acknowledges English teachers who ignite a love for the English language in their students, and are effective in helping their students speak and write accurately.

Students, parents and fellow educators are encouraged to nominate English teachers who

- exemplify the use of good spoken and written English;
- enact learner-centred approaches during English lessons;
- choose pedagogical approaches which are underpinned by knowledge bases appropriate to learners' readiness, interests and learning profiles; and
- develop their teaching competencies to enact classroom practices in alignment with the syllabuses and curriculum, as well as classroom-based innovations.



Nominations open on 1 February 2024 and all forms must reach the Speak Good English Movement by 5.00pm on 5 April 2024.

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6. Arif Budiman Malay Language Teacher Award 2024

The *Arif Budiman* Malay Language Teacher Award (AGAB) is an annual award which recognises outstanding Malay Language teachers who have made significant contributions to the teaching and learning of Malay language in our schools. Since its inauguration in 2007, AGAB has recognised a total of 77 outstanding primary, secondary and pre-university Malay Language teachers.

AGAB 2024 is jointly organised by the Malay Language Council, Singapore (MBMS), the Malay Language Teachers' Association (PGBM), Berita Harian (BH) and the Malay Language Learning and Promotion Committee (MLLPC).

The AGAB 2024 Organising Committee invites students and parents to nominate outstanding Malay Language teachers who are eligible and deserving of the award. Nomination is open from 2 February 2024 to 1 April 2024.
