Through the various self-directed activities that students can do on their own or with their family members, they will learn about:</li> <li>How the Police ensure safety and security in Singapore.</li> <li>What a "crime" is and how to protect themselves.</li> <li>Who, when and how to call the Police.</li> </ul>
	Completed booklets are to be returned to the respective Form Teachers, <u>latest by Thursday, 16 May 2024</u> . The completed booklets will then be handed over to our police liaison officer from Sengkang Neighbourhood Police Centre (NPC) and his team will check and verify the completed tasks. Mystery prizes will be given by Sengkang NPC through our school for completed booklets.
