A 2-day **Design Thinking** workshop will be conducted for all P5 students on **3 May and 10 May**, as part of our school's ALP, *Maker Education*.

The objective of the workshop is to equip our students with the knowledge and skills to:

- 1) identify real-time problems;
- 2) develop problem-solving skills; and
- 3) design and build prototypes to solve the problems.

During the workshop, students will be guided by their teachers and facilitators to apply their critical, analytical and creative thinking skills as well as STEM concepts to ideate and build artefacts to achieve the outcomes of the identified project. Prior to this, the students have also been guided by their Social Studies teachers to carry out some pre-workshop preparation.
