

Look out for the *Travelling Art Cart* at the Sheltered Basketball Court when school reopens in Term 4! Featuring four different themes, this batik-making mobile museum introduces students to two batik artworks by Southeast Asian artists, Sarkasi Said and Jaafar Latif.



Batik painting is the process in which patterns or images are dyed onto fabric, usually using a wax resist technique followed by the application of the dye. Students are encouraged to observe the colours and patterns and share what the batik artworks remind them of.

- All artworks must be original and should not include logos or photographic images of the Contestant or other personal information.

All artworks must be submitted to your child's Form Teacher by 13 September 2024.

- To include 3 to 5 work-in-progress shots or photos of preliminary sketches and/or studies leading up to the final artwork.
- To include high-resolution photo or scan of final artwork (at least 150dpi).
