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#### **4. P1 & P2: Home-Based Learning (HBL) during the PSLE Written Examinations Period**

With reference to [T3W1's Parent Notification](#) (item 2), the school will be implementing Home-Based Learning (HBL) for our **P1 and P2 students** over two separate periods, from 26 to 27 September (for P2 Level) and from 30 September to 1 October (for P1 level), during the PSLE written examinations period (26 September to 2 October):

Level	HBL Days [No School]
P2	Thursday, 26 September & Friday, 27 September
P1	Monday, 30 September & Tuesday, 1 October

The objective of HBL Days is to enable students, parents and teachers to continue to keep in touch with HBL tools and processes so that learning could continue in the event of an emergency school closure.

**During the HBL period, P1 and P2 students are to remain at home** and complete the assigned online and written work. Parents are **strongly encouraged to plan for alternative care arrangements** during these periods. For the assigned online work, please note that your child would need access to a computing device and the Internet from home. They are to complete the online assignments by 6 October.

The Student Care Centre (SCC) will remain open in the afternoon (from 1.30pm to 7.00pm) during the HBL periods.

**P1 and P2 parents** are requested to **acknowledge** the above information **via Parents Gateway (PG) by Friday, 20 September**. If you have any queries or require any support from school, do approach your child's Form Teachers **by Friday, 20 September**.

#### **5. P2 Art Milestone Programme: Exploring My Emotions Through Art**

In Term 4, P2 students will experience a 2-session painting programme that explores watercolour painting during their Art lessons.

This programme aims to help the P2 students achieve the following:

- learn about the intentions and practice of a local artist to develop a mindful and non-judgmental attitude towards artmaking.
- manipulate the use of watercolour painting to develop emotional regulation skills and emotional expression through artmaking.
- learn visual qualities such as colours and gradient in watercolour painting.
- learn about the School Core Values (R<sup>3</sup>ICH) throughout the sessions.

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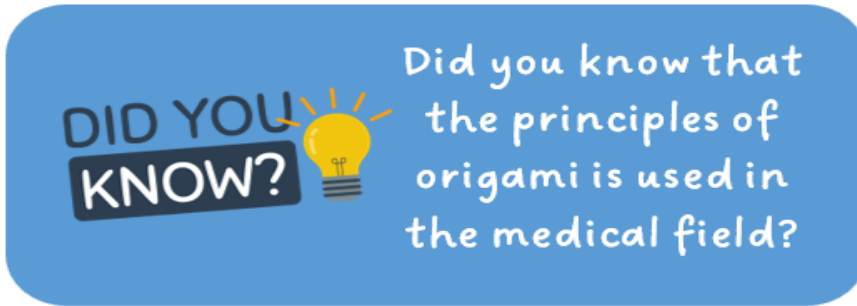
