A printed copy of the FAS form must be submitted under the following circumstances:

- a. families with other dependents (great grandparents, aunties/uncles, cousins, others).
- b. family with more than 6 children in government schools.
- c. family with more than 5 unmarried children not in government schools.
- d. family with more than 3 grandparents in the household.

- Gross Monthly Household Income \$4,800 and below or Per Capita Income \$1,400 and below.
