USSR : Uninterrupted Sustained Silent Reading (Mon to Wed – EL books; Thu to Fri: MTL books)

SEAIP : Strategies to Ensure more Attention to Individual Pupils (one-to-one student-teacher interaction)

CCT : Class Contact Time

FTGP : Form Teacher Guidance Period

CCA : Co-Curricular Activities (for P3-6 students only)

Students are to report to their respective classrooms (or the Multi-Purpose Hall) by 7.30am, beyond which they would be considered late for school.

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#### **4. Arrangements for 2025 P3 to P6 Students**

##### **Dismissal Arrangements for P3 (2025)**

Parents (2024 P2) who used to pick your child at the Drop-Off Point (at the car porch) during school dismissal are reminded that:

- your child will be dismissed at Gate 2 or Gate 4 (kindly make the necessary arrangements with your child if you are picking them up from school); and
- they will be allowed to travel to and from school on their own, without parents having to inform the school.

##### **Attire**

Students would wear the School Uniform from P3 onwards. The table below summarises the attire they need to put on.
